

Protect Your Vehicle

Preservation Parks of Delaware County are safe and enjoyable to visit all year round. Here are some tips and precautions we recommend to protect your vehicle and your valuables:

- Lock car doors and keep windows up. Do not leave car keys in plain view inside your vehicle.
- If you know you are going to the park for a quick walk or run, leave unnecessary items such as electronics, important documents, mail, etc., at home.
- Do not leave valuables including purses, briefcases, wallets, laptops, tools, cell phones, GPS devices, or anything else you value in plain view. Store valuables in the trunk, preferably before you arrive at the park.
- Have your keys ready as you approach your vehicle and lock the doors once you're inside.
- Be aware of park closing time and plan your visit accordingly. Give yourself enough time to make it back to your vehicle safely.
- Keep a list of credit card and bank account contact phone numbers at home. If your purse or wallet is stolen despite your best efforts to keep it secure, you will need to "freeze" your accounts as soon as possible to avoid fraudulent use and identity theft.
