Registration forms will be accepted on a "first-come-first -served" basis. Fees are due at time of registration, and are payable by cash, check or money order.

Cancellation Policy: Refunds will be granted upon cancellation notice as follows:

Prior to registration deadline: 50% refund

After registration deadline: No refund

A full refund will be granted for a medical emergency and if a signed note from the doctor is provided.

Age requirements: Camps are listed by age, and are based on the camper's age on the dates camp is in session. Age-appropriate activities are planned for each session.

Lunch: Children should bring a no-waste lunch to all full-day camps, using re-usable or recyclable packaging. Refrigeration is not available, so include ice packs or pack foods that don't need to be kept cold. All lunches should be clearly marked with the camper's name.

What else should campers bring? Children should dress for the weather, and wear sturdy, closed-toe shoes. No sandals or flip-flops are allowed. More information is included in the registration materials.

Camp staff are trained naturalists with experience working with children of all ages. Preservation Parks volunteers might also work with the camp staff. All staff members and volunteers have undergone a background check and have been trained in CPR and first aid.

Transportation: When trips are provided, campers will be transported to sites outside of Deer Haven and Gallant Farm Preserves by vans, driven by Preservation Parks staff members. Transportation permission forms are included in the registration packet.
