- Assist with volunteer and/or public programs as needed.
- Conduct wetland invasive plant management.
- Assist with other restoration-related activities.

## **Minimum Requirements**:

- Ability to operate ATVs, tractors, backpack sprayer, etc.
- Ability to work long hours, under extreme weather conditions in rugged terrain.
- Willingness to work in the outdoors where standing water, mosquitoes, ticks, snakes and poison ivy are common.
- Experience with identifying wetland vegetation is a plus.
- Near completion of a degree in the natural, environmental, or biological sciences.
- Experience in the use of a technical plant key.
- Coursework in wetlands ecology, botany, and/or statistics.
- Wetland plant and wildlife identification skills.
- Experience with VIBI desired but not required.
