Background:

The OPAL Trails committee was established by the Liberty Township Trustees to help promote the development of improved multi-use trails within Liberty Township and Powell.

OPAL's goal is to help make Liberty Township a safer and more enjoyable environment for walking, running, biking, and other trail-related recreation. This includes both improving and extending the system of multi-use trails within the township. OPAL is coordinating this work with related efforts in Powell, adjacent towns and townships, Delaware County, and Metro Parks to develop a trail system with good connectivity throughout this general area.

OPAL committee members currently include Liberty Township trustees, zoning, administrators and staff, Delaware County Preservation Parks, MORPC, Delaware County Engineering Office, the Liberty/Powell YMCA, a local Powell bike shop, and Liberty Township residents.
