Winter Safety Tips

While visiting Preservation Parks during the winter months, please remember:

- Use caution when snow and ice are present. While we make efforts to keep parking lots and sidewalks free from snow and ice, we do not clear nature trails. Cross-country skiing is permitted on trails when proper conditions exist.
- Do not walk on ice-covered ponds or creeks. Ice skating and ice fishing are not permitted in Preservation Parks.
- Preservation Parks offers two sledding hills at Gallant Woods Preserve and Blues Creek Preserve for visitor use and enjoyment. Please follow the posted sled hill rules. No downhill skiing, snowboarding, or non-commercial sledding devices permitted. Pets must be on a leash and are not permitted to run free on sled hills.

Because of the risk of severe injury during winter conditions, anyone caught on ice-covered ponds or violating sled hill rules will be required to leave the park.
