

Registration is completed online at www.preservationparks.com (on the home page and under programs), with credit cards and electronic checks accepted. Registration will be accepted on a "first-come-first served" basis, and fees are due at the time of registration. For more information, or to contact the education department, call 740-524-8600, ext. 3, or by e-mail: register@preservationparks.com.

Cancellation Policy: Refunds will be granted upon cancellation notice as follows:
Prior to registration deadline: 50% refund
After registration deadline: No refund
A full refund will be granted for a medical emergency and if a signed note from the doctor is provided.

Age requirements: Sessions are listed by age, and are based on the camper's age on the dates that camp is in session. Age-appropriate activities are planned for each session.

Lunch: Children should bring a no-waste lunch to all full-day camps, using re-usable or recyclable packaging. Refrigeration is not available, so include ice packs or pack foods that don't need to be kept cold. All lunches should be clearly marked with the camper's name.

What else should campers bring? Children should dress for the weather, and wear sturdy, closed-toe shoes. No sandals or flip-flops are allowed. More information is included in the registration materials.

Camp staff are trained naturalists with experience working with children of all ages. Preservation Parks volunteers might also work with the camp staff. All staff members and volunteers have undergone a background check and have been trained in CPR and first aid.

Transportation: When trips are provided, campers will be transported to sites outside of Deer Haven Park and Gallant Farm in vans, driven by Preservation Parks staff members. Transportation permission forms are included with the registration materials.
