The Park District's goals are to provide passive recreation activities, such as hiking and picnicking, while keeping development to a minimum. Within the park system, visitors can see meadows, prairies, wetlands, virtually untouched wood lots, ravine systems, waterways, and the remains of glaciers.

Responsibilities:

- Mowing, weeding, trimming, tree trimming, pruning, planting;
- Maintaining vehicles and performing preventative maintenance and repairs;
- Operating power tools and heavy equipment including tractors, backhoes and mowers;
- Janitorial duties (cleaning restrooms and park facilities; removing litter and trash);
- Working on maintenance and construction projects;
- Assuring that facilities are ready for daily use, special functions and or/naturalist programs.

Minimum Requirements:

- Associates degree in Natural Resources or related field preferred;
- Valid driver's license and evidence of satisfactory driving record for insurability;
- Ability to operate hand and power tools, and mowing equipment;
- General maintenance and mechanical skills:
- General understanding of natural resources and environment;
- Ability to work without supervision.
