Spring Safety Tips: Enjoy the Parks Wisely

- Take a moment to stretch your arms and legs before going on a hike.
- Pets must be on a leash **at all times**. Park officers will issue misdemeanor citations to anyone found with a pet off-leash.
- Stay on established trails
- Remember that the parks are natural areas. Watch out for fallen tree branches, loose gravel, and other tripping hazards on the trails.
- Lock your car doors and keep windows up while visiting the parks. Place valuables (purses, GPS devices, cell phones, etc.) out of sight.
- Be aware of weather conditions and advisories (storm warnings, high temperatures, air quality alerts).
- Carry a cell phone and become familiar with park and trail names so you can tell 9-1-1 operators where you are in the event of an emergency. All trail names are posted at trail starting points, and in park maps and kiosks.
- All parks have trash receptacles available near parking lots and picnic shelters. Please don't litter.
