



Seasonal Park Technician

Preservation Parks of Delaware County is currently seeking temporary Seasonal Park Technician positions from summer 2012. Hours may vary but are typically Monday-Friday from 7:00 am to 3:30 pm. These positions are excellent opportunities for a candidate in a Natural Resources program to gain valuable work experience.

Our Park Operations staff members are professional and proud of the quality of our parks and their role in keeping the parks in excellent condition. The Park District's mission is to provide passive recreation activities, such as hiking and picnicking, while keeping development to a minimum. Within the park system, visitors can see meadows, prairies, wetlands, virtually untouched wood lots, ravine systems, waterways, and the remains of glaciers.

The Seasonal Park Technician will perform a variety of landscaping and groundskeeping activities including mowing, weeding, trimming, tree trimming, pruning, planting, etc. He or she will: perform janitorial duties, clean restrooms, park facilities, pick-up litter, and remove trash; work on maintenance and construction projects; and assure facilities are ready for special functions and or/naturalist programs.

Required qualifications are a valid driver's license and evidence of satisfactory driving record for insurability; ability to operate hand, power tools, and mowing equipment; general maintenance and mechanical skills; general understanding of natural resources and the environment; and ability to work without supervision.
